

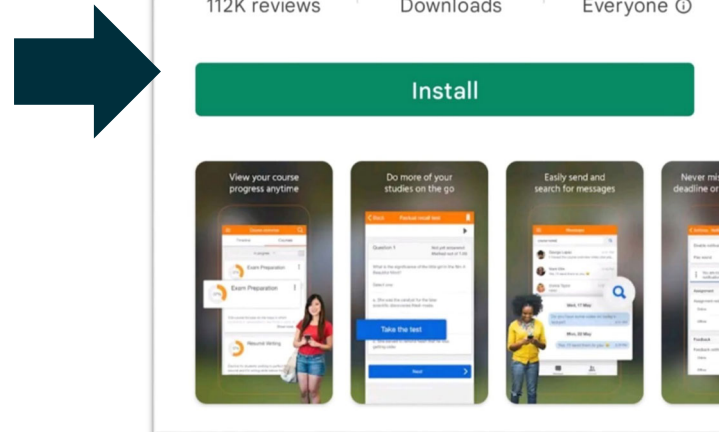

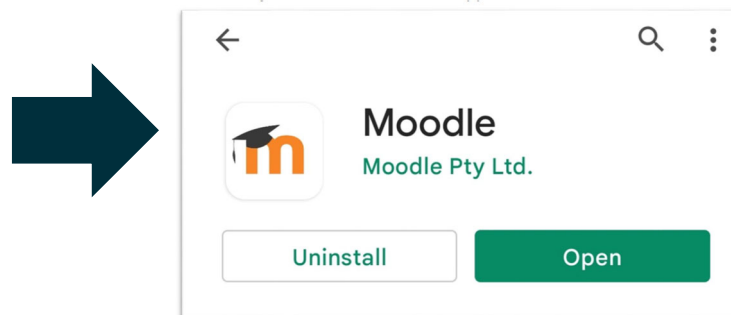

install the Moodle app.



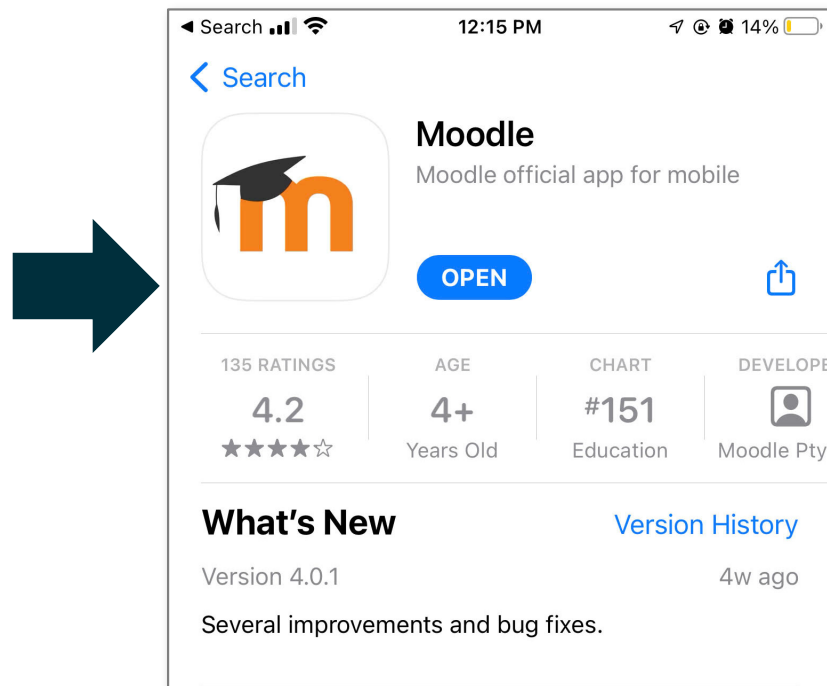
Click open to open the app.

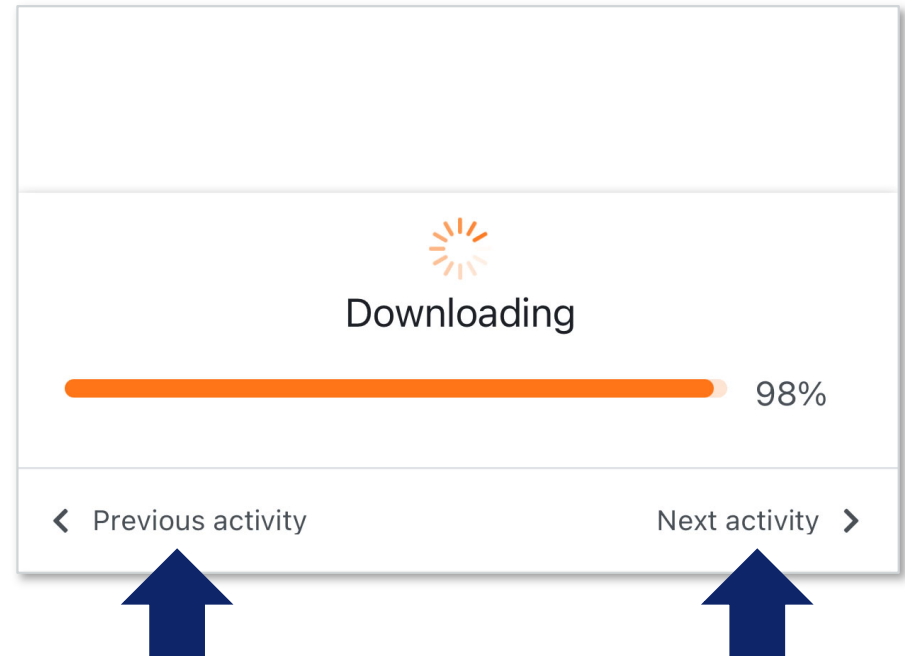
Once logged in, you can click

You will see a list of available courses and any progress you have made.

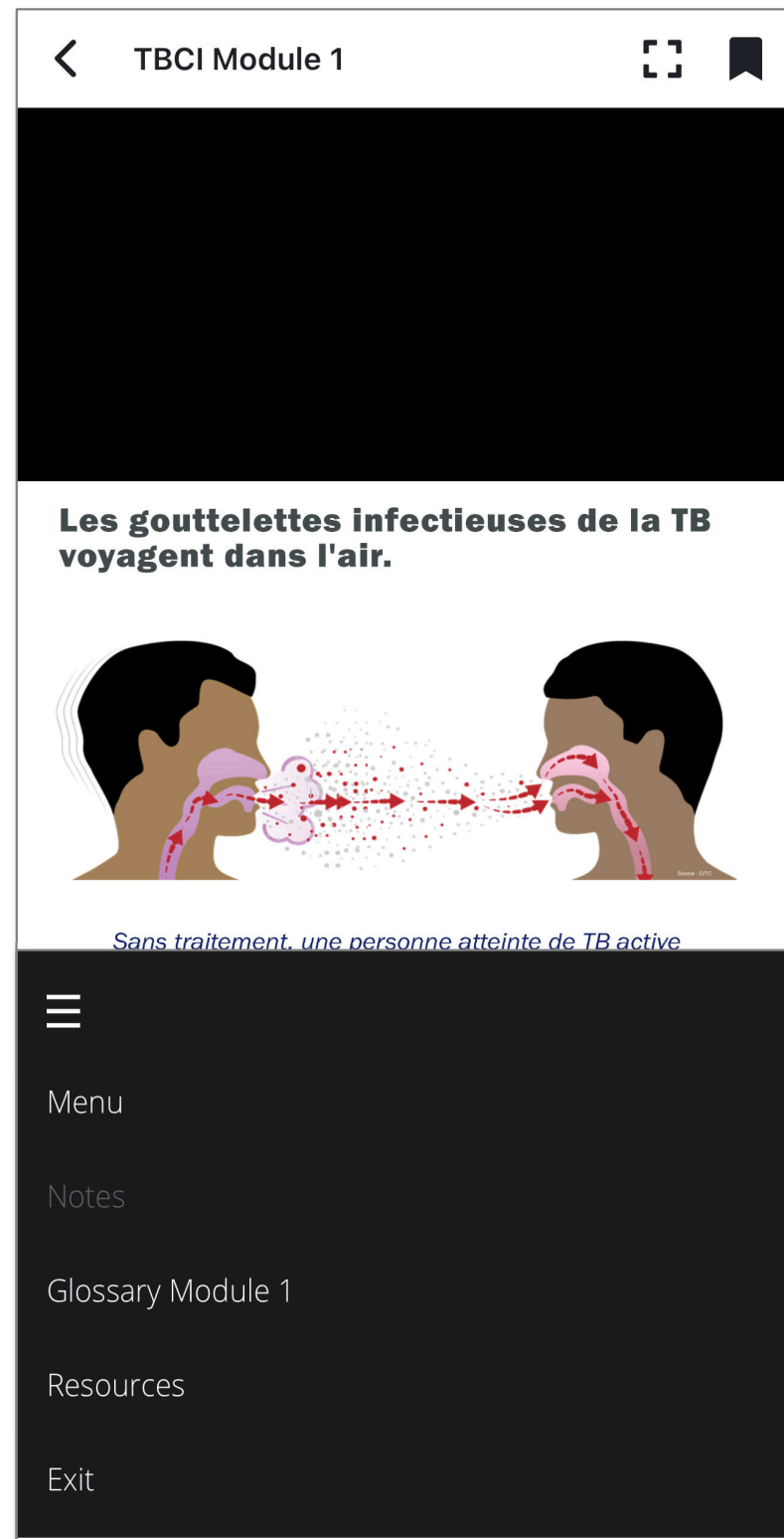


The activity will download to your device and load.
